Year 6 Bikeability - Shakespeare Irwin and Cadbury classes

As part of our school's commitment to issues concerning safety, the road safety team from Leicestershire County Council have been invited to teach aspects of cycle safety. The scheme is called 'Bikeability', the aim of which is for participants to achieve a road safety award when cycling on their bicycles. The scheme will be free of charge.

Each child will need a bicycle and helmet to participate and these will need to be brought to school on the relevant days. Participants must be able to ride their bicycle. Before any practical training takes place, bicycles will be checked for roadworthiness. Those that do not meet the required standard (size of bike, brakes, tyres etc.) cannot be used on the course. After that, a series of practical 'on road' cycle sessions will follow, in which the children will also need their bicycles.

We strongly believe that this is a valuable opportunity, and urge as many children as possible to take part. We regard this as a positive and valuable experience for your children. If you wish your child to participate, please complete the tear-off slip below and return it to school by Friday 29. November 2024. There is a maximum of 24 places which will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The training will take place on the following dates Tuesday 3⁻⁻ December to Friday 6⁻⁻ December 2024 weather permitting. You will receive confirmation of allocated groups closer to the dates.
