RESEARCH

Just like our Year 7 students, delve into the world of Greek myths and legends! Research Greek gods and goddesses and the stories Greek civilisation was built around, such as Medusa, Zeus, Theseus and the Minotaur and Pandora's Box. You could read a book, research on the internet or watch a film - we love the Percy Jackson series!

Get lost in their world and pick your favourite myth or legend!



DESIGN

Greek mythology was often depicted on vases and vessels, so now it is your turn to design your own! Think about...

- Can you use decorative pattern work like the ancient Greeks did?
- Is your vase going to be 3D or 2D?
- How will you tell the story on your vase?
- Which colours would work best?
- Will it be a traditional design or have a modern twist?



CREATE

Your artwork can be made out of anything! You could do a drawing, model air-drying clay, use recycled materials - get creative and bring your myth/legend to life!

There are only two rules:

1. Your artwork must feature at least three images/designs to represent the beginning, middle and end of your chosen myth/legend.
2. You need to come up with a caption or title for your piece.



SUBMIT

To enter simply email a photo or scan of your artwork to thebridge@thehinckleyschool.co.uk, along with your name, primary school and the title/caption for your piece. **OR** Bring your artwork into the Main Reception at The Hinckley School, Butt Lane, Hinckley, LE10 1LE, ensuring that you include your name, primary school, parent/carer contact details and title/caption with your piece.

Deadline for submissions is: 8am, Tuesday 5th May 2026.

Entries will then be reviewed by our Year 7 judging panel and guest judge Dr Jane Ainsworth, with the winners contacted shortly afterwards.
