



YEAR 3&4 EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO COOMBE ABBEY- TUESDAY 7TH JULY 2026



Objectives

Every child has an entitlement to a wide range of educational experiences. Each year the school will arrange a number of activities that take place off the school site and/or out of school hours, which support the aims of the school, as well as providing first hand experiences and bringing the curriculum to life.

Aims

Basic information

Date: Tuesday 7th July 2026

Time: The coach is leaving school at 9.10am so please arrive promptly at school as normal so we can prepare for the journey.

Cost: **£13.60** per child.

Other information: PE kit is to be worn along with sensible footwear such as trainers. If the weather is warm, please provide a sun hat and apply sun cream at home. If the weather is wet, please provide a water proof coat.

Itinerary

Our main activity will be 'den building'. The children will be working together in teams to design, build and test various dens. The children will be challenged to find and test suitable materials in the woods to build their own den.

We will then have a picnic in the park and enjoy some time on the adventure playground. We will return back to school by the end of the day. Children need to be collected at the normal time.

Lunch

All children will need a packed lunch. Free school meal children will be provided with a packed lunch from the school kitchen. However, they will still need to bring a drink of water or squash (no fizzy drinks please). Packed lunches from home should be in a named **disposable bag**.

Adult:Child Ratio

- All educational visits are led and supported by competent adults.
- There are qualified first aiders supporting us on this trip.
- All adults supervising this educational experience have a DBS certificate.
- There will be a minimum of 6 adults with the class on this trip.

Consent/payment

- Please make payment of **£13.60** through Parent Pay by **Monday 22nd June 2026**. By making payment, you are giving consent for your child to attend the trip.
